Palm Sunday

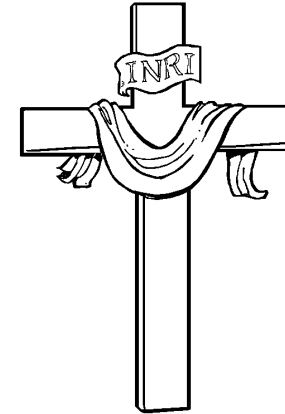
Vigil Mass Saturday March 15, 5:30 PM,

SAINT BEDE THE VENERABLE 2008 LENTEN SCHEDULE



Lent is the penitential season of the Church Year that begins on Ash Wednesday and continues to the Mass of The Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. Then the Paschal Triduum celebrates the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Rules of Fast and Abstinence

Abstinence applies to all Catholics 14 years and older. This means that they may not eat meat on Ash Wednesday and Fridays during Lent.

Fasting applies to all Catholics 18 to 59. This means they may eat only one full meal on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Two smaller meals may be eaten in addition to the one full meal. No meat is allowed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
